Dear Students,

Berlin, May 2011

It took quite a while until all the funds could be brought together, but now we are delighted to finally give you feedback on your involvement on WOW-Day 2010.

This year, the campaign has been incredibly successful again. On a single day, you have raised € **313.293,76 €** (as of Mai 20, 2011, with 149 participating schools) by taking up one-day jobs and by helping with many creative activities. Have you ever thought about how many hours of work you all have dedicated to the cause, together with entire school grades or the whole school? With this money it will be possible for us to support disadvantaged children from 43 Waldorf- and other educational initiatives in 21 countries.

150 schools from 15 countries have registered for WOW-Day 2010: Belgium (1), Denmark (2), Germany (128), Finland (1), France (1), Great Britain (3), Italy (1), Luxembourg (1), Norway (9), Austria (1), Poland (1), Sweden (1), Slovenia (1), South Africa (1), Hungary (2), Ukraine (1)

On behalf of all children, we would like to thank you wholeheartedly for your exemplary commitment. You have contributed to the fact that schools, nurseries and social-work initiatives gain the assurance that there are people like you out there, on the other side of the world, thinking about them and willing to help.

“Your WOW-Day donation has been the lifeblood of the Puppetry Club Movement for the last few months and will see us through to end October. (...) This has been an extremely busy year with 3 puppeteers giving some 90 puppet shows monthly in the local Educare centres (...) and some 20+ small puppetry clubs being run weekly in the homes of the club leaders. Indeed keeping up with the training of the club leaders is itself a daunting task as none of the leaders (ordinary mothers and grandmothers) has ever had any training or experience of arts or crafts in their limited schooling experience. But the joy that is expressed over the simplest of activities fills my heart with delight and thanksgiving for being able to offer such experiences to these ladies. Then when one sees how the children react - well that is something that has to be witnessed!

Yesterday I was collecting one of the club leaders to take her to the First Aid Course and she had 7 young children (7 - 12 years) working in her house making angels in preparation for our Christmas activities. The girls crowded round the door, waving and full of smiles as the leader's daughter took the group for the rest of the period. The leader in question has never worked outside her house, she is a polio victim since age 3, wears iron callipers, walks with a bad limp and is often in pain - she left school after 3 years. Her daughter in early 20s and has been very withdrawn and introvert but thanks to the



puppetry she has come out of herself, now works with the children and writes her mother's weekly puppetry club reports. I think this is an indication of how the clubs can act as leaven in the homes. Then to add to the picture of yesterday afternoon, Audrey, the lady in question, brought to the First Aid class a large bag full of lovely angels made of batting by her club members. The other club leaders were in awe of what Audrey's groups had achieved - and no doubt many went home thinking, "Wow! if Audrey's clubs can do that so can mine!"

Please tell the Waldorf children in Europe that their WOW-Day funding is of considerable importance and that we would love to show any of them or their parents who may be visiting South Africa how we are using the money they have so enthusiastically collected. Children helping children - across the oceans - on the other side of the earth - speaking different languages and enjoying different cultures, but all going through this most exciting period of childhood. These words are meant to represent all the initiatives and express the gratitude of all children worldwide, who are now able to benefit from improved education and living conditions. It is very important that we collectively accompany the disadvantaged children and it is more important to show regular support, even if small, than to give a single large donation. But the most important part is the feeling that we are all connected, no matter where we come from.

In 2011, WOW-Day will go a step further. On September 29th, the event will expand on a European level on the occasion of the 150th Anniversary of Rudolf Steiner. 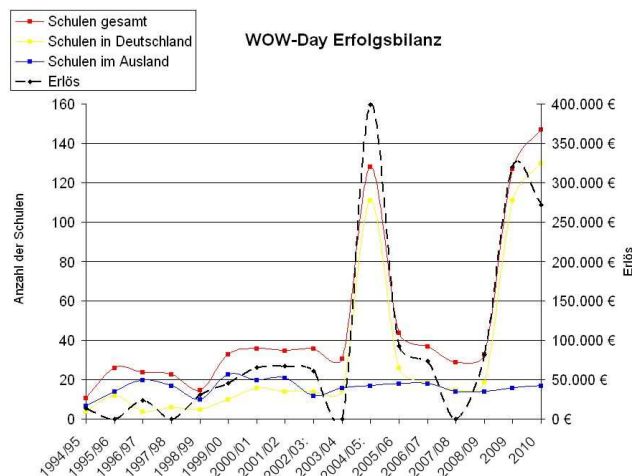
